DISTRICT 7980 HELPS CLINTON AND SOUTHEAST CT.

Our Rotary District 7980, in concert with The Rotary Foundation, put together a COVID-19 Relief Initiative that is unprecedented. In less than 30 days the District 7980 Foundation Leadership established five ways to initiate support to those in need.

1. **The Rotary COVID-19 District Food-Drive Fund** placed \$30,000 in place so that every club in the District could put food on the shelves of its local food bank for families in need.

2. **The COVID-19 Emergency District Managed Grant Program** established \$32,500 for 25 projects in communities to support first-responders.

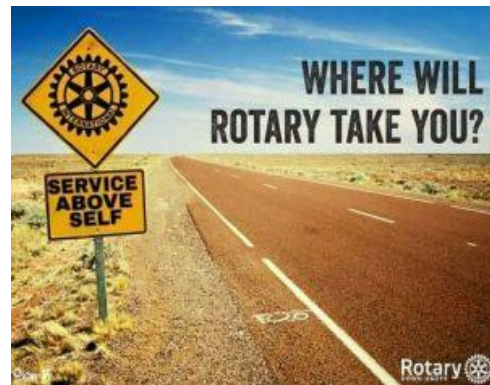
3. **The District was awarded a \$23,050 Rotary International Disaster Grant** that earmarked funds to provide Personal Protection Equipment for local medical facilities, from masks and gloves to protective gowns.

4. **Rotarian Ted Rossi of the East Hampton Club made a personal**

donation of 28,000 medical protective masks to be distributed to town first-responders.

5. **District 7980 COVID-19 applied for a Global Grant** that will deliver more than \$40,000 in funds for PPE equipment in support of hospitals and medical facilities across District 7980.

That means over \$104,000 of Rotary Foundation money is working for us in Southern Connecticut during this crisis.
