- 3. Evidence of acceptance to an institution of higher learning (vocational school or college)

Students must fill out this application form personally. Please be neat, concise and use separate pages only if necessary. All information given will be kept confidential among The Rotary Scholarship Selection Committee.

All applications must be postmarked or brought to the Morgan Guidance Office by end of day, Friday, May 2
